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

- Small, but growing!
 - 1 student per cohort (CNA & Automotive)
 - Both WIOA approved
 - Support Class built in time to focus on state exam for CNA
- Strong collaborative relationships among the ICAPS Advisory Team
- Other students join the Support Class
- Establishing other ICAPS
- Accuplacer (entrance exam) preparation tutoring at Sandburg
- Library Study Room reservation for ICAPS Support Class
