FY23 NRS DATA

- ▶ In FY23, we had ~926 students identified as ICAPS Students.
 - ▶ Over 1/3 of the credentials earned by learners could not be counted on our NRS Performance Reports.
 - ▶ The credentials we couldn't count also don't count for future performance funding at the local level.
- ▶ Why so few credentials able to be counted?
 - Data entry
 - Students were in error status and were not countable
 - Confusion about what goes where
 - Students were not marked as an ICAPS student
 - Confusion about what goes into DAISI
 - Bridge Courses versus ICAPS Students

REQUIREMENTS FOR FY24

- ▶ All ICCB Adult Education funded programs **MUST** run a Bridge AND an ICAPS in FY24.
 - ▶ These are identified by students in DAISI.

▶ What if my program doesn't?

It could result in:

- ▶ Corrective Action Plan
- ▶ Reduced Funding
- ▶ Lack of Demonstrated Effectiveness for the next competition cycle, which means not being funded at all.



What About Students From Other Funds?

If you need to enter students into DAISI from funds other than Adult Education and Family Literacy funds, you will need to use funding codes 4900 and 4910.

What is the difference?

- ❑ 4900 is for unrestricted funds (i.e., institutional dollars)
- ❑ 4910 is for other restricted funds (i.e., additional grants from ICCB or outside sources)

Note: All Adult Education eligibility and NRS assessment policies apply.

LET'S WALK THROUGH THIS!


- ▶ Gerberding Academy (GA) receives an Innovative Bridge and Transitions (IBT) grant from ICCB. GA plans to use these funds to build a Welding ICAPS. The IBT grant is going to pay instructors for planning/creation time and the Support Course. When GA enters students into DAISI, the funding code would be 4910 (other restricted funds).
- ▶ Gerberding Academy (GA) receives money from their Foundation to pay for their Healthcare Bridge course to be used as a pipeline for the Academy's Pharmacy Tech Program. When GA builds the Bridge course in DAISI, the funding code would be 4900 (unrestricted funds).
- ▶ Pre-testing is required for both of these scenarios because pre-testing is required for DAISI use.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT EDUCATION

Any person who:

- has attained 16 years of age;
- is not enrolled or required to be enrolled in secondary school under state law;
- And also
 - is basic skills deficient (below 9th grade level in math or reading);
 - does not have a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent, and has not achieved an equivalent level of education; or
 - is an English language learner.
